WAMITAB Level 2 Certificate for Sustainable Waste Management Operative (QCF 501/1855/9)

Qualification summary

Achievement of the qualification demonstrates competence by the learner to operate appropriately and in accordance with employment requirements as determined by the units selected, within a waste management environment.

The qualification is assessed 'on-the-job' at a suitable waste management facility which may include working on public highways or other areas accessible by the public or other persons.

The structure of the qualification includes some Units which are specified in other similar WAMITAB waste management 'operative' qualifications.

The qualification provides progression opportunities by utilising units that are common to other waste management QCF qualifications. Furthermore, earlier qualification of a similar type can, through for example, recognition of prior learning (RPL), enable progression to the learner to achieve this or other qualifications appropriate to their employment.

To achieve this qualification learners must complete 10 units - (minimum credit 33) all of the units in Group A (the mandatory group - consisting of 24 credits) and then one unit from Group B and then any three units from the remaining Groups ensuring that at least one of the Units is at Level 2 and in doing so complying with any restrictions associated with groups C, D and E should you choose any units from these groups to count towards your optional total. Credit Value required: Minimum 33. Sub-components required: Minimum 3.

A - Mandatory Group - Learners must complete all units in this group to achieve the qualification.

Credit Value required: Minimum 24.

Sub-components required: Minimum 6.
