

Work Based Qualifications

What is Technical Competence?

If you operate a waste facility with a permit there is a requirement for you to show that you are a "Fit and Proper Person"- now called Operator Competence. Part of this is based on your Technical Competence.

The WAMITAB Work Based Qualification scheme recognises your practical skills and knowledge in waste management.

What is involved?

The relevant qualification is based around the work you carry out on site and you will be expected to demonstrate that you are working to the appropriate standard....the actual term used is "competent".

You can demonstrate your competence in a number of ways. For example, your assessor will want to watch you do things, ask you questions and speak to others who work with you. You will also need to put together a portfolio of evidence, to include the different documents you use on site.



How long will it take?

This depends on you, the site and how much time you can allocate to completing the work involved. We suggest it might take between 6-18 months depending upon the qualification being completed.

At an initial meeting one of our assessors will work with you to agree an assessment plan that reflects your specific needs and circumstances.

How much will it cost?

We offer a range of different approaches to suit your needs. This will include site visits, but we also try to use technology as much as possible, with an e-based portfolio option.
